Sport Horse In-Hand: To be shown on the triangle; horses will be divided according to age as of January 1, 2008, but not gender. Please see Special Notes on the next page for explanation of age. Horses that are two years or older must be shown bridled.

Just Jumpers: Two courses offered at each height, ribbons to 6th for each course

Crossrails	18" (no spreads or combinations) optimum time (no jump-off)
Pea-green	2" (spreads to 2', no combinations) optimum time (no jump-off)
Chicken Little	2'3" (spreads to 2'6") optimum time (no jump-off)
Low Jumper	2'6" (spreads to 3') clear rounds to jump off
Schooling Jumper	2'9" (spreads to 3') clear rounds to jump off
Open Jumper	3' (spreads to 3'6") clear rounds to jump off
High Jumper	3'6" (spreads to 4') clear rounds to jump off

***Jumper Jackpot:** two divisions- 2'-2'3" and 2'6"-2'9". See Special Notes for details. Payback! \$15 entry.

***Gambler's Choice:** 2'6"-3'. See Special Notes for details. Payback! \$15 entry.

DIRECTIONS TO TRINITY FARM

From Valdosta – Take I-75 South to State Road 6, go west (right) onto 255 North. Go north 1/2 mile, the farm will be on the left.

From I-10 & Lake City – I-10 west toward Tallahassee. Exit north (right) on 255 (Lee, FL exit). Head north about 7 miles until you cross SR 6. Continue on 255 for 1/2 mile, the farm will be on the left.

From Tallahassee – I-10 East to 255 (Lee, FL exit). Head north on 255 about 7 miles until you cross SR 6. Continue on 255 for 1/2 mile, the farm will be on the left .

HOUSE RULES:

1. *Please, NO DOGS! Leashed or otherwise they will not be allowed on the premises.*
2. All riders must wear protective headgear when mounted. Juniors must wear ASTM/SEI certified helmets with the chinstrap fastened.
3. Management reserves the right to divide or combine classes, if necessary, as needed.
4. Be safe, courteous, and above all – HAVE FUN!!!

AWARDS:

Awards – Ribbons to 1st – 6th in all divisions. Special awards to: Dressage High Score (both Junior and Senior), Combined Test Overall Low Score. Ribbons 1st – 6th for each course for Just Jumpers. Trainer Award to trainer who brings the most students/entries – be sure to have them put your name on their entry!

SPECIAL NOTES:

Sport Horse In-Hand: Please be sure to calculate the horse's age properly. The horse is recognized as the age it will turn in the calendar year starting on January 1st. (ex: On June 30, 2007 the horse turned 2 years old. Since the horse will be a 3 year old in 2008, it is to be reported as a 3 year old.)

Jumper Jackpot: offered at two height divisions, 2'-2'3" and 2'6"-2'9". Requires 3 riders to fill each division or that class will not be held. Clear first rounds will jump off for time. Payback from entries to three places: 1st = 50%, 2nd = 30%, 3rd = 10%, 4th-6th ribbons.

Gambler's Choice: fence heights 2'6"-2'9". Fences will be assigned point values; competitor has 60 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. Any rails knocked down will not count for points and that fence may not be jumped again. One attempt at the "Joker" fence will be permitted after the 60 seconds ends for a premium point value. Requires 3 riders to hold the class. Pays first three places: 50%, 30%, 10%, with ribbons to 4th-6th.

Know all men by these presents, that I, the undersigned (hereinafter referred to as "participant"), desires to engage in and does hereby engage in the following equine activity, to wit the Suwannee Valley Chapter of Deep South Dressage & Combined Training Assn. Spring Schooling Show on April 12, 2008, located at Trinity Farm, Lee, FL. Participant does for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, waive and release any and all claims for damages, death, personal injury or loss of property against the Suwannee Valley Chapter of the Deep South Dressage and Combined Training Association, also known as SVCDSRCTA, it's officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives, which may arise from participating in or observing equine activities at or sponsored by SVCDSRCTA, even if caused in part by the negligence or negligent actions or other fault of the parties or persons I am release, or by the dangerous or defective condition of any property or equipment owned, maintained or controlled by them. My participation in or observation of equine activities at or sponsored by SVCDSRCTA are done at my own risk. I will assume my own medical and emergency expenses in the event of an accident or other incapacity of injury resulting from or occurring in my participation in or observation of equine activities sponsored by SVCDSRCTA.

For in consideration of the above activities, services and entry fees paid, receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Participant hereby does forever and finally release, remise acquit, satisfy and forever discharge the Equine Activity Sponsor of and from all manner of action and actions, cause and causes of action, suit, debts, dues, sums of money, bonds, billings, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, damages, variances, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law and equity, which may arise or might in the future arise or hereinafter may arise for or against the Equine Activity Sponsor for the activities as stated above .

Further, I understand that the above hold harmless agreement does additionally apply in whole and full to the owners, managers, lessor, and lessee of the physical property upon which the event will be held, said property being commonly known as Trinity Farm, David J. and Linda L. Boyles, Owners, located in Lee, FL .

This document is meant to be a full complete release from any and all liability that may arise from participating in the above-described equine activity. This release is given freely and voluntarily by the participant and is meant to remain in existence throughout the duration of the equine activity.
